ROD TAYLOR, STAR OF "THE HELL WITH HEROES," KEEPS PORTABLE DRESSING ROOM-OFFICE ON SET

Rod Taylor knows how to combine business with business.

He has designed a portable dressing room which also is equipped with a desk, files, plug-in telephone switchboard and all the other essentials for a business office.
